DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments):

Candidates applying for the position must hold a doctor's degree in history in the field of 19th or 20th century history. The candidates should prove their academic achievements in the field of contemporary general history with a special emphasis on the history of the United States, as well as military history and social history. International experience (internships, fellowships, research scholarships abroad) and teaching experience (at the academic level) would be additional assets. Proficiency in Polish and advanced level of English are required.

The documents should include:

- Cover Letter addressed to the Rector of the University of Gdańsk;
- Curriculum Vitae;
- Personal data form;
- Summary of personal accomplishments;
- Diploma transcript of doctor's degree (PhD) in history, and the specialty of history in 19th or 20th century;
- List of academic publications and other research information (incl. research grants) in the field history of history in 19th or 20th century;
- Information on other accomplishments in didactics and research (e.g. popular science, activities in scientific societies);
- Two references from associate professors with at least one employed in an academic/scientific institution other than the University of Gdańsk; The references should include information about the qualification, predisposition for scientific and didactic work,
- Good command of the Polish language;
- Candidate's declaration that in case of winning the competition, he/she undertakes to prepare and conduct courses in English within his/her teaching load,
- A candidate's declaration that the University of Gdańsk will be the main employer once the candidate has won the contest,
- Consent to the processing of personal data for the purposes of recruitment, in accordance with the Law on Personal Data Protection 29.08.1997 (Journal of Laws No. 133, item 883 with later amendments).

Candidates should submit their applications to the Dean's Office, Faculty of History, University of Gdańsk, Gdańsk, Wita Stwosza 55, room 2.29.

The University does not provide accommodation.

Deadline for submitting application: **16 March 2017**

The contest will be adjudicated by the Competition Committee no earlier than two months – counted from the date of contest announcement.

Department of History reserves the rights to close the contest without selecting a candidate. The rejected candidates will not be informed about the result proceedings and their documents will be destroyed.
