DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments): Applicants for the position must hold at least a PhD degree in Ethnology. The candidates should prove the academic achievements in the field of the anthropology of migrations and related ethnic, linguistic and social transformations, ethnic minorities, and experience in ethnological Field Work, and acquiring and conducting scientific grants. Proficiency in Polish and advanced level of modern foreign language are required.

The documents should include:

- Cover Letter addressed to the Rector of the University of Gdańsk; to the Rector of the University of Gdańsk;
- Curriculum Vitae
- A copy of PhD diploma in humanities, ethnology
- The list of academic publications in the field of the anthropology of migrations and related ethnic, linguistic and social transformations, and ethnic minorities
- Experience in ethnological field work
- Experience in and acquiring and conducting scientific grants.
- Educational and organizational achievements, with experience in the organization and improvement of the learning process, popularization of knowledge, scientific cooperation, membership in scientific societies
- Two references from associate professors with at least one employed in an academic/scientific institution other than the University of Gdańsk; The references should include information about the qualification, predisposition for scientific and didactic work,
- A candidate's declaration that the University of Gdańsk will be the main employer once the candidate has won the contest
- Good command of the Polish language
- Candidate's declaration that in case of winning the competition, he/she undertakes to prepare and conduct courses in the English language within his/her teaching load,
- Consent to the processing of personal data for the purposes of recruitment, in accordance with the Law on Personal Data Protection 29.08.1997 (Journal of Laws No. 133, item 883 with later amendments).

Candidates should submit their applications to the Dean's Office, Faculty of History, University of Gdańsk, Gdańsk ul. Wita Stwosza 55, p 2.29.
