• Health Insurance:

*UW-Parkside health insurance plan is required for all international students. For some exchange programs, the insurance may be waived ONLY after a thorough review of an alternative plan from the student's home country. This alternative health plan will be approved by the Offices of the Dean of Students & the International Student Office.

To be approved for a waiver, a complete English copy of the alternative insurance plan should be submitted and the WAIVER FORM completed and sent to the International Student office. The alternative health insurance policy should be a maximum of \$500,000 in coverage for <u>emergency care</u>, <u>hospitalization</u>, <u>evacuation and repatriation</u>.

• How to Make Payments:

STUDENTS WHO ARE SELECTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF GDANSK MUST FOLLOW THESE STEPS IN ORDER TO APPLY:

- 1) Students complete on-line application
- 2) Submit TOEFL scores
- 3) Submit Sponsorship Form
- 4) Submit Bank Statement
- 5) Submit University of Gdansk Transcript

Once the above documents are received by the Admissions Dept., students will be sent an acceptance letter & an I-20 document. They will then pay an on-line SEVIS fee (\$200) & schedule an appointment to meet with a U.S. Visa officer to receive an F-1 visa to enter the country. Once they receive a visa, they can book a flight to the U.S. and send our office (International Student Services) information about their flight so that we can arrange airport pickup
