Dear **UG Students** interested in attending a class taught by professors of **University of Michigan Dearborn** in the **Spring semester!**

Between May 2 and June 24, 2022, meeting three times a week (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday) two classes will be offered by UM-D teachers (Visiting Professors at UG)

1. **COMP/ENG 223: Intro to Creative Writing**

U.S. Credits: 3 (typically 6 ECTS); Professor Bill DeGenaro, <https://umdearborn.edu/users/bildeg>

Writing while traveling and while doing out of the box things like living/studying abroad is an important (some would say essential) part of experiencing the world and reflecting on those experiences. Using the writings of Polish authors as examples, you will write genres like poetry, the short story, and the “creative non-fiction” essay.

2. **JASS/COMM/M&CL 381: Postwar European Cinema**

U.S. Credits: 3 (typically 6 ECTS); Professor Jorge Gonzalez del Pozo, <https://umdearborn.edu/users/jorgegdp>

The course will concentrate on a series of films with special attention given to those that focus on the pivotal role of Poland and Gdańsk in socio-political issues, historical events and cultural preoccupations that have defined and also challenged European societies from WWII to the present. Themes such as memories of war and the Holocaust, new conflicts, class, immigration, women's rights, gender, and East-West relations will be addressed.

20 students in each class will be American students at UM-D who are coming to UG for two months. **There are ten seats in each class allotted to the UG students**, at no cost.

REQUIREMENTS for UG students as stated by the UM-D (institution offering the class):

1. English competence B2 or higher
2. Covid vaccine (or request medical or religious exemption)
3. Since UG students will be listed as Non-Degree Guest Students at UM-D, Guest Application must be submitted in accordance with UM-D regulations.
