



David F. Forte is Professor of Law at Cleveland State University, where he was the inaugural holder of the Charles R. Emrick, Jr. - Calfee Halter & Griswold Endowed Chair. He has held Distinguished Fulbright Chairs at the University of Warsaw and the University of Trento, and he was the Garwood Visiting Professor at Princeton University. He holds degrees from Harvard College, Manchester University, England, the University of Toronto and Columbia University.

He has frequently testified before the United States Congress and consulted with the Department of State on human rights and international affairs issues. His advice was specifically sought on the approval of the Genocide Convention, on world-wide religious persecution, and Islamic extremism. He has given over 300 invited addresses and papers at more than 100 academic institutions, was the chairman of Professional Ethics Committee of the Cleveland Bar Association, and is the Vice-Chair of the Ohio State Advisory Committee to the United States Civil Rights Commission.
