Thomas W. Simons, Jr. served two tours at the U.S. Embassy in Warsaw, 1968-1971 and 1990-1993 (as Ambassador). A career U.S. diplomat (1963-1998), he was also the policy official responsible for relations with the USSR and Eastern Europe in the second Reagan term (1986-1989) and visited Poland often during those years. He holds a B.A. from Yale and an M.A. and Ph.D from Harvard, and his best book is Eastern Europe in the Postwar World (2nd rev. ed., 1993), a history of the area under Communism. He is currently a Visiting Scholar at Harvard's Davis Center for Russian and Eurasian Studies.
